There will be an estimated 150,000+ new cases of colorectal cancer this year, and screening truly saves lives.

Greater access to gastroenterologists is needed to meet growing patient demand. Yet, according to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, gastroenterology will be among the top fields with the highest predicted provider deficit as demand for specialists rises. By 2025, Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) predicts a shortage of 1,630 providers.
