

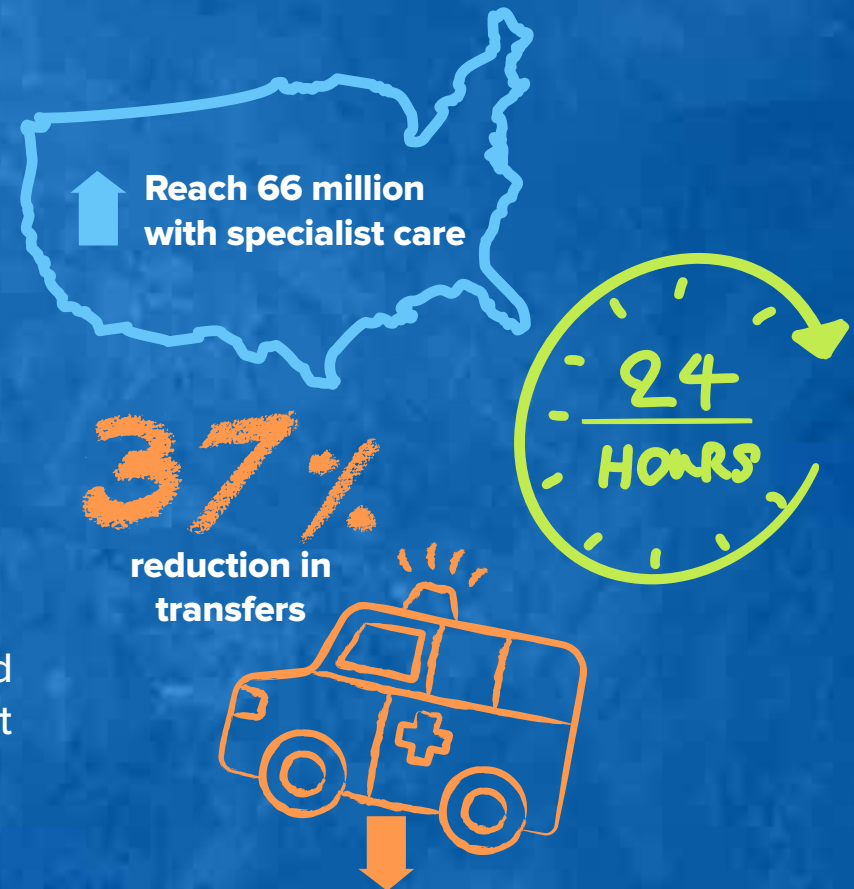
The ABC's of Telemedicine

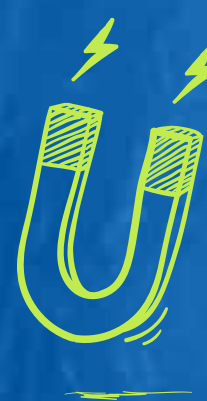
A: ACCESS TO HIGH-QUALITY CARE

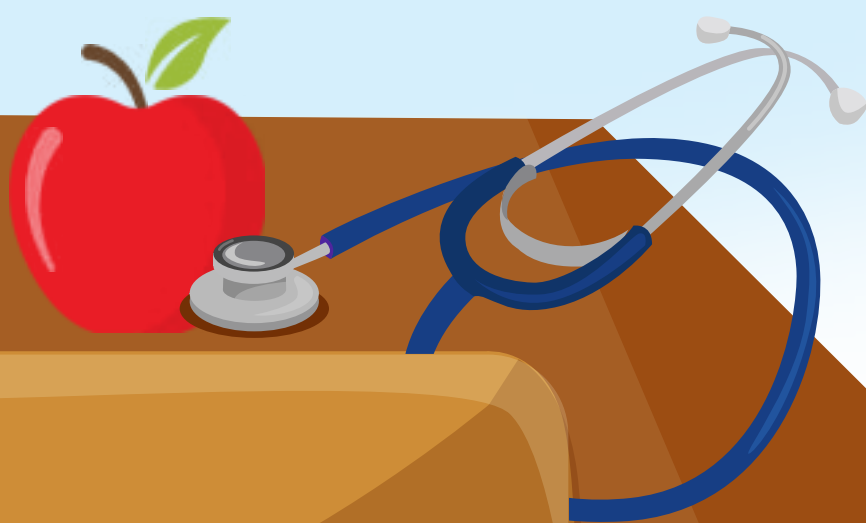


C: COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC HEALTH
